Dear Kimberly:

I oppose several of the the proposed changes the TLC is currently attempting to make regarding the Lotto Texas on-line game rule and the Instant ticket game reports.

I believe all 6 of 6 winners should receive the **same EXACT percentage of sales** and not one cent more or one cent less. I do NOT agree with the TLC paying the “advertised jackpot amount” instead of the rightful percentage of sales due the 6 of 6 winners.

I do not agree that there could ever possibly be “carry-over” money for the top jackpot prize when there is a 6 of 6 winner in Lotto Texas.

I do not believe the executive director has a right to set a “maximum total cash amount or maximum payment time period for each prize level.”

I believe Lotto Texas **should remain a pari-mutuel game** meaning all prizes are based on a percentage of total sales.

Pertaining to the Instant ticket rule - I strongly **oppose the deletion** of the paragraph that reads, “Game report. Following the last day on which prizes may be claimed after termination of a game, the executive director or his/her designee shall prepare a report that shows, at a minimum, the total number of tickets sold and the number of prizes awarded in the game. The report shall be made available for public inspection.”

I believe the people have a right to this information so do NOT delete this paragraph.
